i.	Utangulizi	Ukanda wa Misitu ya Miombo Tanzania Bara pamoja na maeneo kame ya Zanzibar, yanakabiliwa na changamoto kubwa ya umasikini, hususan katika maeneo ya vijijini unaosababishwa na kuongezeka kwa Idadi kubwa ya watu pamoja na matumizi hafifu ya mbinu bora za kilimo kutokana na Athari za za Mabadiliko ya Tabianchi. Vilevile, vikundi vya wajasiriamali wadogo na ushirika vilivyopo kuwa na uelewa mdogo katika matumizi ya mbinu bora za kilimo pamoja na kuwa na upatikanaji mdogo wa rasilimali za kifedha. Hivyo, kusababisha watu wa maeneo husika kushindwa kuhimili changamoto za athari mabadiliko ya tabianchi na kupelekea uzalishaji mdogo wa mazao ya kilimo na mazao yasiyokuwa ya misitu yenye thamani ndogo ya soko.

Participatory mapping, identification, and prioritization of both local and evidence-based adaptation practices, appropriate technologies, and innovative approaches to enhance resilience of prioritized value chains (horticulture in cooperation with the University of Zanzibar (SUZA)) 4. Development of Zanzibar NTFP strategy integrating climate concerns, building on the national NTFP strategy developed through the DSL IP 5.
